1 Maitre De Chai Blanc de Blanc 11% vol (1) France An excellent crisp French dry white with a fine bouquet.	£1.95	£6.50	£11.95
2 Maitre De Chai Demi Sec 11% vol (4) France Very full flavoured, fruity yet medium-dry to taste.	£1.95	£6.50	£11.95
3 Maisons Des Bretons (6) France Sweet white Vin de Pays. A soft smooth sweet white wine from France.		125ml £1.95	75cl £8.95

4 Il Meridione Cataratto £9.25
(1) Italy
A light bodied white from Sicily with savoury, almond and floral aromas. Goes with a whole host of foods.

5 Pinot Grigio Ponte di Piave £9.40
Veneto (1) Italy
Very light and neutral, revealing just a hint of green fruit. Ideal with spicy dishes, chicken or fish.

6 Vistamar Sauvignon Blanc £9.40
(1) Chile
Full of varietal character with gooseberry/grassy aromas. A beautifully balanced, well rounded, crisp, clean wine, matching well with fish and seafoods.

7 Aimery Viognier £9.95
Vin de Pays d'Oc (2) France
The classic Viognier notes of peach and apricot are present on this dry and mild bodied white. One to accompany scallops, crab and mild to medium curries.

8 The Landings Chardonnay £9.95
(2) Australia
On the dry side of medium dry, a very fresh and fruity white wine to accompany an array of flavoured foods such as chicken, seafoods and summer salads.

Red Wines – Gwin Coch

9 Maitre De Chai Rouge 12% vol (B) Full of character, medium bodied, smooth and satisfying.	£1.95	£6.50	£11.95

10 Il Meridione Nero d'Avola £9.25
Italy (B)
Produced from the native grape of Sicily, the Nero d'Avola. A deep ruby red with juicy blackberry fruit which mingles with a hint of subtle spice. Goes well with sausages and chops. Ideal too with roast beef and juicy loin of lamb.

11 Vistamar Merlot £9.40
Chile (C)
A gentle textured red with nuances of black cherries and herbs. Enjoy with a grilled steak and salad or on its own.

12 Monte Clavijo Tempranillo £9.95
Spain (B)
Soft juicy red rioja with lots of plums and black fruit flavours. Ideal with lamb and surprisingly good with curries.

13 Boomerang Bay Shiraz £9.95
Australia (C)
No wine list is complete without a classic Australian Shiraz. Soft tannins integrate with juicy black fruit flavours and a velvety texture. Incredible value for under a tenner! Try with meat stews, duck, turkey or whatever you fancy!

14 The Landings Shiraz/Cabernet £9.95
Australia (C)
Another recommended Aussie favourite, a smooth and easy drinking wine full of blackberry and plum fruit flavours with a tantalizing hint of spice. Ideal with red meats and pasta.

15 McGuigan's Black Label Red £10.95
Australia (D)
Our final red from Down Under, kept by popular demand. Brian McGuigan's Hunter Valley special, full, rich, round and ever so smooth.

Rosé Wine – Gwin Rhosliw 75cl

16 Jack Rabbit White Zinfandel £9.40
California (6)
We think this will be our top seller. A light, fresh rosé, medium sweet with delicate strawberry fruit character. Mainly for enjoying on its own, really easy drinking.

17 Boomerang Bay Rosé £9.95
Australia (4)
A dryer rosé experience that has aromas of banana and raspberry. Ideal for a warm summer's evening.

Sparkling & Champagne – Byrlymus/Siampen 75cl

18 Asti Spumante Santero £9.95
Italy (6)
The classic sparkling sweet sparkler with a full fruity flavour.

19 Portacelli Cava Brut £10.95
Spain (2)
Fresh, elegant, harmonious, tempting and deliciously dry...yet with just a light touch of sweetness.

20 Champagne Chimère Brut £19.95
France (1)
Our recommended "House" Champagne composed of 30% Chardonnay and 70% Pinot Noir for under twenty quid – amazing value. Celebrate and don't feel ripped off!

(1) Pinot Grigio Veneto – Ponte – Italian. Light and neutral.

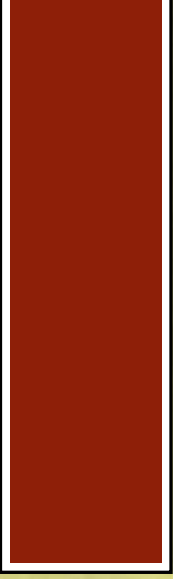
Rosé
